### ***Breakfast, Cafés, Diners***

Basell's Restaurant & Tavern, 4880 Victoria Ave, ☎ +1 905 356-7501. Daily 6am-9pm  
Although described as a 'hole-in-the-wall' it's hard to find a bad review of this place. From copious breakfasts, to dinner specials that include soup, coffee and dessert, Basell's offers great value AND serves beer.

The Flying Saucer, 6768 Lundy's Lane (look for the UFO), ☎ +1 905 356-4553. Daily 6AM-11PM. This diner/greasy spoon is best known for its breakfasts, and is very crowded on weekend mornings (expect a wait). Yes, it's really shaped like a Flying Saucer, but the locals lovingly call it the Flying Dump. Cheap and greasy is the concept here.

Savoury and Sweet, 3770 Bridgewater Street (just off Niagara Scenic Rt near Marineland), ☎ +1 905 295-2000 7AM-8:30PM. Savouryandsweet.com  
Self-described as "reasonably priced, generous portions and fresh made meals (no pre-mixed granules, frozen potatoes or canned soup)." Café atmosphere is relaxed, stylish and European. Has 28 varieties of crepes (savory and sweet), including breakfast crepes til 11:30am, all of which you can eat-in or take-out.

## ***Lunch, dinner and late-night***

Tarboosh Mediterranean Grill, 5809 Victoria Ave (at the top of Clifton Hill), ☎ +1 905 353-0909. 11AM-3AM. This could well be one of the only options for late night, and apparently has delivery service. Menu includes shawarmas, falafel, burgers, samosas, springrolls, ice cream, and freshly squeezed juices.

Taps on Queen, 4680 Queen Street (Corner Valley Way) ☎ +1 289-477-1010 tapsbeer.ca With its own microbrewery on-site, you'll find quality beer grub (pizza, sandwiches and burgers) that ranges from \$12 – 18 per plate.

Antica Pizzeria, 5785 Victoria Ave, ☎ +1 905 356-3844. 12PM-11PM anticapizzeria.ca Thin-crust pizza made to order in wood-burning ovens. Can be busy at dinner time. \$10-16 per entrée.

Suisha Gardens, 5701 Lewis Ave, ☎ +1 905 354-1500 5PM-10PM. suishagardens.com Very pleasant Japanese restaurant. They cook Teppanyaki-style, at your table, have sushi and vegetarian options. Good for a large group. Take-out available. Reservations recommended \$16-\$40 per entrée.

Yukiguni, 5980 Fallsview Blvd., ☎ +1 905 354-4440 12PM-10PM Reasonably priced sushi, teriyaki and udon. Traditional Japanese style restaurant that is popular with Japanese tourists.
